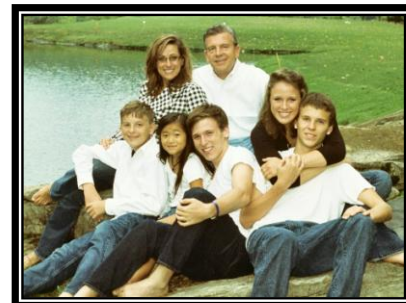


## THE BIG BUILD

Allow me to introduce you to a friend of mine, JT Olson. He is an inspiration to me and many others and God is using him in incredible ways. JT founded an organization called Both Hands ([www.bothhandsfoundation.org](http://www.bothhandsfoundation.org)). Both Hands is the best organization I have seen with the purpose of exercising religion that is pure and faultless. **However, to continue helping the widows and orphans, we need your help!** Please take a few minutes and read about this ministry.



### The Genesis of Both Hands

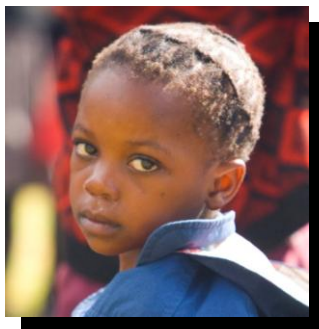
Both Hands came as the result of a simple letter JT sent to a friend. He wrote to ask if his friend would sponsor him in a golf marathon. The funds would go to a wonderful ministry for women in crisis pregnancies. JT's friend sent the letter back with a handwritten message saying that **he'd gladly support his efforts if he was working on a widow's house instead of playing golf.**

For five years that letter stuck with him, until another friend, who was adopting four orphans from Moldova, expressed his **need to raise funds to pay for the adoption.** That's when the idea for Both Hands grew legs. JT and his friend recruited others, located a widow's home in need of repairs, enlisted local businesses to donate supplies and food, and hundreds of people wrote checks to sponsor the workers that day. It was an amazing day! **This group of Christ followers raised \$55,000, almost enough to cover the costs of the adoption expenses, and they totally transformed the widow, Miss Lucille's home.**



### The "Big Build"

**Every dollar raised in "The Big Build" will be multiplied by 2.** One will go to a fund at Lifesong for Orphans that will provide money for both Christian families who have a heart to adopt but do not have the financial capacity to do so and orphan care projects all over the world. The other dollar (match from philanthropist) will cover Both Hand's 2010 operational expenses. **Both Hands in turn will provide the coordination and direction to serve 50+ widows and will allow 50+ orphans to find a forever home in 2010.** These are the people your contribution will serve and that's a 250 - 500% return on your investment.

### Spotlight: The Widow – Debbie Jackson

Debbie lost her husband to a heart attack on Memorial Day, 2004. She has done a terrific job of raising three kids on her own, however, there are a few things around her home that need addressing. We on the Both Hands Big Build team are going to scrape and paint the trim of Debbie's home.

We will also pressure-wash moldy siding, replace rotting fascia board, remove old carpet, clean the grille, move some furniture and do some all-round spring cleaning.
